Your friends at school/work want to hold a talent show, what will you do to impress them?

Where do you set sail
first? Be sure to convince
your shipmates or they might rebel, making you walk the plank!

Time to step up to the plate... it's your turn to cook everyone a meal, what are you making and why?

You have power over the weather. If it could be one season forever, which would it be? Each player must give a different reason if the same season is chosen.

## Cheat!

You notice someone at the table has been cheating during a board game. What do you think the consequences of this behaviour should be and why?

Everyone names their favourite activity, and why they like it - each person then chooses
which person's activity they would most like to try out for themselves.

What is your favourite holiday / special occasion? This can be anything from Bonfire Night to Pancake Day!


You are starting a new life on a tropical island. You need to make a fire and shelter, supplies must be gathered, and the island needs to be mapped. Looking around the table who would you take with you and why?

You have to cook each family member a special meal, what will you cook to brighten their day and why would you choose this meal?

Calling Downing Street... Going around the table, if you were prime minister, name a law you would pass on your first day in office - remember, you have to have a good argument/reason for choosing this new law!


## Game night!

Each person at the table wants to play a different video game, how do you decide what to play?

You and your family are hosting a party, and each family member must take responsibility for something different, including a lead act (i.e., singer, comedian, dancer), entertainment and dress code. Who takes on what?


Someone at school / work dresses differently from everyone else, and you notice others talking about this in a negative way - what do you do?
